## Promoters Conditions

This competition is promoted by Havant and Waterlooville Swimming Club, which is affiliated to the South East Region ASA, and is held under Amateur Swimming Association (ASA) laws and ASA Technical Rules of Racing.

### Entries

Acceptance of Entries: This is a licensed level 3 competition (3SExxxx). Upper limit qualifying times apply and swimmers must not enter the individual event if their time is already faster than that stated on the Schedule of Events. Ages are as at midnight 25th April 2010. All swimmers must be registered with the ASA. It is the swimmer's responsibility to ensure his/her eligibility for each event. If capacity is reached, swimmers rejections will be made firstly on with the basis of swimmers entering the least number of events, then by slowest entry times.

Electronic entry files are the preferred method of entry for this meet. Electronic entry files and instructions will be distributed on request. If you do not receive electronic entry files, please contact [brian.meaden@ntlworld.com](mailto:brian.meaden@ntlworld.com). Alternatively Individual Entry Forms may be submitted electronically. All entries must be submitted with a completed Club Entry Summary Form. If paper entries are submitted, a 25 pence levy is charged per event as an administration charge.

Submissions must be received before midnight of the closing date 28th March 2010. A cheque (payable to H&WSC), and copy of the completed Club Entry Summary Form must be posted to Brian Meaden, H&WSC, Waterlooville Leisure Centre, Waterberry Drive, Waterlooville, PO7 7UW. One cheque is required to cover all club entries. Cheques must be received before April 5<sup>th</sup> 2010. If entries are submitted in paper form, these must be submitted with the cheque, to be received by March 28th 2010.

Swimmers will be distributed in heats from the submitted entry times. Improved times will not be accepted after the entries have closed. All Events will be swum on a heat declared winner (HDW) basis. The final heat will be spearheaded. All starts will be at the deep end of the 25m pool.

There will be no entry cards for this meet. Confirmation of entries shall be sent electronically to each club secretary at the email address provided on the team summary form. Team coaches will be given a document to record withdrawals on the day of the meet. **Withdrawals must be made by the time the first warm up for each session commences.**

On the day of the meet, there will be a charge for entry for adults wishing to support their swimmers. The entry charge will be £5 for all day admission, or £3 for either the morning or afternoon sessions. Note that this charge is inclusive of the meet programme.

### Awards

Points for the Top Visiting Club Trophy will be awarded on the following basis for swimmers finishing in the top eight in each age group. In the event of a tie between clubs, then the award will be decided on the basis of the highest number of first places or, if necessary, second places, etc.

Prizes will also be awarded to the Top Boy and Top Girl swimmer in each age group, calculated on the same point's basis.

1st: 8 pts, 2nd: 7 pts, 3rd: 6 pts, 4th: 5 pts, 5th: 4 pts, 6th: 3 pts, 7th: 2 pts, 8th: 1 pt

Medals shall be presented to the top 3 competitors in each individual event. These can be collect from the announcer's desk.

For any matters not covered by these conditions the meet promoter will make any decisions it deems necessary to provide for the satisfactory running of the competition. By submitting an entry, participants have deemed to agree to such decisions.
