**CAPITAL PERFORMANCE BY H&WSC
AT THE WELSH CAPITAL OPEN MEET 2011
IN CARDIFF 26 AND 27 NOVEMBER 2011**



Five of our top male swimmers and young Ella Francis, rising JP swimming star travelled up to Wales at the weekend to compete at the Level 1 Open Meet event at the Cardiff International Long Course Swimming Pool.

Accompanied by Head Coach Graham Pople on poolside, our young swimmers were competing against top successful Swimming Clubs such as the City of Cardiff Swimming Club, Severnside Tritons, Edinburgh University SC.

Supported by parents over a very long arduous weekend at this attractive venue, 32 swimming events took place including 1500m races. Our small elite team of swimmers swam exceptionally well—bringing into fruition all the long months of hard training and earning many medals between them.

4 of our 6 swimmers placed in medal positions, with most of them recording their own best ever swims in the process. Oliver Jermy was placed 11th overall in the open Top 20 Men Individual Scores for the event.

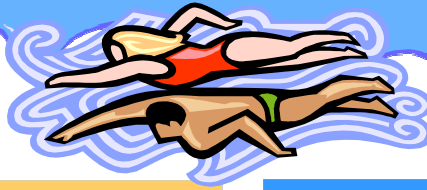
Out of 52 clubs present at the meet, H&WSC, with just six swimmers, managed to pull out the stops to accrue enough points and finish 15th place in the overall club placings with 409 points. Home club City of Cardiff won top place with an astounding 3,872 points. The best visiting club was the Severnside Tritons.

CHRIS HUNT MEMORIAL CHANNEL CHALLENGE

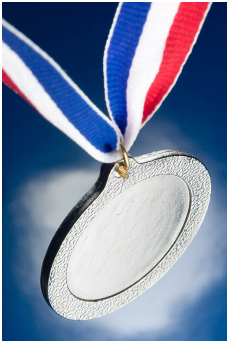
Saturday 7 January 2012 4—6pm at Waterlooville

Who is Chris Hunt? This event is in memory of Chris Hunt, a very keen open water swimmer and long standing Master swimmer with the club, who died on poolside in 2007 after suffering a massive heart attack during a masters training session. Ever since, we have organised the Chris Hunt Channel Challenge in his memory and to raise funds for the British Heart Foundation. The challenge is to swim the equivalent distance to France and back in our 25m pool. And all in Butterfly!—Chris's favourite stroke.



In 2011 we did exceptionally well, managing to swim the channel plus an extra 30 miles! We raised well over £600 from the swimmers £3 entry and donations on the night, for the British Heart Foundation—the nominated charity. All of Chris's family attended, from his Mum right down to the great grandchild in the pram! Also last year, the club was honoured to have The Worshipful The Mayor of Havant present to start the event for us, and remain on poolside for much of the time, taking a great interest in the proceedings and spending time talking with members of the club committee. The event was covered by the Portsmouth News, with an official photographer.

Please make sure you put this date in your diaries. All swimmers in all squads from Foundation to Masters are invited to swim and to make a small donation. Bring along parents to cheer you along—they can even get in the water and swim a length or two if they want to join in.



Masters swim to silver medals

A group of our master's swimmers competed in October at the Masters National Short Course Championships and 5 of them came away with silver medals.

Pauline Hogg, Lynne Jones Tina-Marie Parkin and Karen Blanchard gained theirs in the 4 x 50 metre medley relay.

Sue Dewar and Pauline were placed second in their individual events.

Steve Thomlinson and Adam Perrott also competed with Steve winning two Bronze medals.

The relay swim was a particularly good achievement from members of a single club, as many of their opponents were swimming for much larger or combination clubs.

Lynne, Tina-Marie, Steve and Adam were also selected to represent Hampshire at the Masters inter-county event held in Guildford. They were part of the Hampshire team who were placed first overall in the South East Regional section of the national
